- * **Proposal**: To change the dates of the **TBRCNA** to Labor Day Weekend. During a year when the World Convention Narcotics Anonymous (**WCNA**) is held in United States the **TBRCNA** will not be held. This change will not take effect until **TBRCNA-15**, **2015**
- * Intent: To follow the **Eleventh Concept of Service** and be prudent with our **NA** funds. Traditionally the month of February has always been a busy time in the convention industry. Hotels are booked years in advance and rates increase with the lack of availability of rooms. By moving to Labor Day weekend we can take advantage of lower rates and more room availability. With the new rotation of **WCNA** we would only be in conflict once every six years. By not having a **TBRCNA** during the time **WCNA** is in the United States will allow our members to enjoy and budget monies for that event.
