RCM Report August 18Th, 2013

Good Afternoon everyone, My name is Val V. and I'm a grateful addict in recovery. I attended the **Summer 2013 Regional Service Conference** last week that was held Beaumont, Texas. I have several issues to discuss with you and they are as follows.

- (1) The **Southern Zonal From** will be held on January 24Th thru 26Th in Houston Texas at the Houston Hilton North Hotel. The room nights are \$79.00 per night for either a single or double occupancy room. The phone number is 866-577-1154 and all are encouraged to attend.
- The **CAC** is looking for two new members to join them. This position has a 7-year clean time requirement and is a 5-year commitment. They have been asked to present at the next **RSC** their plans on building a timeline book for the **TBR** Convention to help the next members that have to facilitate the event. It has been an ongoing effort on their part yet nothing has been presented to the **TBR** body. Needless to say, there was a heated discussion over this matter and it time to put pencil to the paper and produce something for us to look at.

Otherwise, voting is done by a show of hands. TBRSC Facilitator votes only in the case of a tie. Cofacilitator is excluded from voting on all proposals before the RSC. The Administrative Committee members shall have no vote on old business proposals which have been sent back to the Areas for consideration. Positions of service are voted on by paper ballot or by hand if nominated individuals are

not present. Majority is 1 plus half of the voting member (Regional Trusted Servants) present. Ouorum
