LITERATURE: Lydia R.: Current Balance \$2520.60. Needed to collect from Area for P.R- Treatment Associates.
\$118 deposit.

OLD BUSINESS: Lidilla nominates Carol for literature co-chair. Carol qualifies herself and is voted in. For purposes of getting added to the literature bank account, the minutes contain her full name: Carol Loupe. Stephen nominates Jerrie for activities chair. Jerrie qualifies herself and is voted in. Tom nominates Julia for recorder/secretary. Julia qualifies herself. Senior adds that she is the best. Julia is voted in.

Jerrie asks for \$300 for karaoke machine, she has found one to purchase. Stephen asks how we would decide who can use it because it would belong to the Area, not just the activities subcommittee. Don says it would be locked at the clubhouse and asks if it would have a warranty. Shelley voices a concern that there could be conflicts of interest if more than one group or subcommittee wants to use it at the same time, who would get preference? Tom suggests a sign-in/sign-out sheet. Stephen suggests that ASC would vote on use of the machine during the ASC meeting. Tom points out that this area doesn’t have overlapping events, so there wouldn’t be any scheduling conflicts. Jerrie asks who would purchase the machine since it will belong to Area and Troy says activities would make the purchase. Lidilla asks if a group uses the machine, would the GSR be responsible for it and Troy says yes. Aharon wants to take the vote on the karaoke machine back to his group. Proposal is tabled. Don indicates that GSRs are entrusted to make decisions. Aharon withdraws his request to discuss with his group. The motion for karaoke machine passes.

Outreach is requesting \$150 per month for gas and wants to be able to use the money for more than one vehicle. Tom points out that in the past, there have been problems with filling up multiple cars and it has gotten out of hand. Richard says ASC should pay for gas because it encourages more people to go. Megan asks if local meetings are included in the gas budget and Matt says it’s only for meetings outside Corpus Christi city limits. Rodney points out that the cost to fill up a tank varies depending on the type of vehicle. Stephen suggests it needs to be a flat rate. Tom says four trips per month outside of city limits with two cars wouldn’t add up to \$150. Megan suggests a set rate per mile and asks if the meetings that outreach has been visiting are in need of support. David suggests that this conversation needs to be rolled into the budget discussion. Troy says we need to trust the trusted servant. Vinny suggests that there needs to be an inventory of which meetings need support from outreach subcommittee.

Megan makes a motion to remove the meeting that occurs at Broken Chains from the schedule. Lidilla points out that this group has never attended ASC meetings. Troy reminds us that groups who do not attend ASC meetings can stay on the schedule. Senior points out that in his experience, the meetings at Broken Chains are not NA meetings. Matt agrees that they do not follow

an NA format. Tom seconds the motion to remove this meeting from the schedule. There was no opposition and the motion passes.

Shelley proposes that ASC meetings return to being held in-person rather than hybrid. Senior asks if there are any groups outside of Corpus Christi who benefit from attending ASC via Zoom. Don points out that the Zoom option did not start due to Covid, but was started in order to include outlying groups such as Beeville and Victoria. Aharon suggests an amendment to the proposal to rotate ASC location. Richard points out that we just paid rent to CBRC for the entire upcoming year for ASC. Lidilla reminds us that the literature bank is at the clubhouse and Tom says it would be too difficult for Lidilla to travel with literature. Shelley amends the proposal to say that ASC administrative officers are required to attend the meeting in person. Troy points out that this would require a policy change. Stephen adds that we could vote on paying for gas for outlying groups to attend ASC meetings. Lidilla says that paying for gas to attend the ASC meeting is a home-group issue. Don reminds us that Area is here to support groups and ASC should pay for gas for GSRs to attend the meeting. The proposal to require officers to attend in-person has been tabled. GSRs will need to take this back to their groups: should ASC meetings be held only in person or keep the hybrid format/option?

Budgets: Outreach is requesting \$150 per month (\$450/quarter), budget passes. RCM 1&2: \$250/quarter for gas & hotel, budget passes. Phoneline: \$150/quarter, budget passes. Web servant: \$100/quarter, budget passes. PI/PR: \$600/quarter, budget passes. H&I: \$600/quarter, budget passes. Activities budget is an active & variable flow–no budget set at this time. The ASC will need to review budgets in three months.

NEW BUSINESS: Texas State Donation was tabled, Tom proposed to generate funds CBANA support. Bring back to groups for ideas and solutions. Shirts for Quilts was tabled. Area was pushed to 4th Sunday of the month. Steve Nominates Jason Blanpied for ASC Treasurer. It was passed by all qualified members. Needing a Co-Facilitator for Area, which needs to bring back to groups. Jerry R’s Donation for Activities was passed by all qualified members for \$300. Policy Change was for RBS donation to 50% to 25%, after 3 months we decide what we will donate.
