Subject: Final report for the Service System Inventory Ad-hoc

An area inventory is used in much the same reason that the individual addict does a personal inventory: to stop, consider their actions, attitudes, and behaviors and finally rededicate themselves to the ideals of helping the group to service the addict in need. The area inventory is broken into 3 separate categories. First, How well has the area committee done at serving the groups, and how can it better serve them in the coming year? Second, How well has the area committee served the larger community, and how can the committee better serve the community-at-large? And last, How well has the area committee done at supporting NA regional and world services. The Coastal Bend Area scored lowest on the first category by their voting group members.

Date: March 18,

During the February ASC, members voted to concentrate on the 4 lowest scored questions from the results of the area inventory. A mini-workshop was performed and information was collected from the assigned groups. The questions were as follows:

- Question A.5 How fully does the area train & support members who serve on the area service committee?
- Question A.11 How well has the area fostered the willingness of the local fellowship to volunteer for service positions?
- Question A.12 How well has the area practice continuity and rotation?
- Question A.13 How well does the area function in maintaining a full complement of trusted servants, with no open commitments?

From the min-workshop a decision tree to promote further ideas was made from CBANA members. However, no other feedback was provided thru email, texts, or CBANA Facebook account. The following are suggestions accumulated by information gathered thru ad-hoc communications and from the mini-workshop concerning the above questions. The suggestions are intended to be simple solution based ideas to address all above questions. They are up for review and approval by this ASC.

- Currently there is not a set format for training members into the responsibilities of the different areas
 of service at the ASC level. The following suggestions are to provide for training and support of those
 areas.
 - Formal training hosting annual event for area service in which each service chair speaks about their individual position responsibilities, accomplishments, and personal God moments. Guide to local service may be tied into this event for interested members.
 - Informal training CBANA pamphlet explaining roles, responsibilities, and requirements prior to position changes for interested members.
- 2. Adopting a "sponsorship" role in the different areas of area service to promote continuity and rotation within CBANA. Fostering an attitude that Area Service is my "other home group".
 - Policy change to allow a transition period between when one service chair leaves that the incoming chair trains. Area may consider budgeting for ongoing training at other local NA events concerning that area of service.
