Insurance for groups and areas

There was talk about many places nowadays asking for groups to carry liability insurance for their group as prerequisite to allowing them to meet at their facility, church, hall, whatever. We have been encouraged to look at Bulletin 33 on NAWS.

The thought is that if the area buys it, the cost would be fairly split by the number of meetings not groups. So if there are 52 meetings like I counted for the CBANA the annual cost would be split by 52. The groups, like OTW that have several more would pay more.
