-Continuing virtual meetings for ASC post-pandemic

Ed says we'd have to purchase equipment for CBRC. The idea is to still meet at CBRC and still allow those outside groups having trouble with traveling and those who are out of town, to still attend.

But what will this look like financially?

Approximately \$50/month for Internet with donated equipment.

Troy wants to know if we're really going to try to pass this with only 4 GSR's present....

Don says this is not something that NEEDS to be voted on right now.

Tiffany V. makes a motion to table this discussion.

This motion is seconded.

Don believes this is something to think on when things "go back to normal"

NEW BUSINESS:

Ed says only the Admin do not have voting "rights" at ASC, and that you *can* hold a subcommittee chair position, Area position, and the GSR position and still be able to vote. Richard says this is correct. Tom M. says when he was Lit chair, he had a vote. Mario says ALL GSR's have a vote, even if they hold a chair position for a subcommittee. Troy says Admin (facilitator, co-fac, RCM 1, RCM 2), even if they are GSR, cannot vote.

Rocky says this is a moot point without the Policy.

Policy states that GSR's only (or alt GSR in absence of GSR) can vote. Don says if you hold a chair position at the AREA level, you need to give up the GSR position. Ed says that's a problem, since most people in CBANA "where two hats".

Don is going to work on a solution as he "revamps" the ASC policy.
